Dr. Scoville is an independent consultant specializing in healthcare quality improvement and performance measurement. He is an Adjunct Professor in the Department of Health Policy and Administration at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill where he teaches courses in healthcare quality improvement and informatics. He serves as an improvement advisor to the Institute for Healthcare Improvement, NICHQ, the Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center, and the Federal Health Resources and Services Administration on a range of collaborative improvement and systems design projects.

Dr. Scoville recently served as a policy analysis in a RAND Corporation study of the impact clinical information systems on the U.S. health care system. He founded Canopy Systems, Inc., a successful care management Internet-based software product, and served as its Chief Technology Officer.
