Dr. Kate Cronan is the Director of Medical Content Integration for KidsHealth and a pediatric ER doctor at the Alfred I. duPont Hospital for Children in Wilmington, DE. She graduated from Temple University School of Medicine and completed her internship, residency, and fellowship training at The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia. Prior to February 2008, she was the Chief of Emergency Medicine at duPont Hospital for Children for 17 years.

Currently, Dr. Cronan is Associate Professor of Pediatrics at Jefferson Medical College. She has served as chair of Delaware's Emergency Medical Services for Children Coalition for 7 years and is co-chair of the Child Death Review Panel for New Castle County. She is board certified in Pediatrics and Pediatric Emergency Medicine. She is a fellow of the American Academy of Pediatrics, and a member of the American College of Physician Executives. She has been voted a "Top Doc for Kids" in Philadelphia Magazine and Delaware Today Magazine and has been named to the "Best Doctors in America<sup>®</sup>" database 2007-2008."

Dr. Cronan has written a number of articles and book chapters in the field of pediatric emergency medicine. She co-authored First Aid Tips for Parents (Sandvik Publishers, 1999), is co-editor of Pediatric Emergency Medicine Secrets (Hanley and Belfus, 2000; second edition 2008), and served as the US medical editor for 2007 and 2008 DK publications: I'm a Mom! Now What? and Growing Up: A Parent's Guide to Childhood. She authored several chapters on childhood health and safety in two leading middle-school textbooks.

Dr. Cronan lectures regionally and nationally. Her specialty is visual diagnosis in pediatric medicine. The media frequently call on Dr. Cronan for her expertise. She has appeared on dozens of local and national TV shows including NBC's TODAY Show, and also writes a monthly column for The News Journal in Wilmington, Delaware.
