Charles J. Homer, MD, MPH, CEO

Dr. Homer is a pediatrician and a founder and Chief Executive Officer of NICHQ. He is an Associate Professor of Pediatrics and of Public Health at Harvard University and was a member of the third US Preventive Services Task Force. He served as chair of the American Academy of Pediatrics Steering Committee on Quality Improvement and Management from 2000-2004. Prior to his position at NICHQ, he was director of the clinical effectiveness program at Children's Hospital, Boston, and served as program director of federally supported fellowship training programs in pediatric primary care and health services research. Dr. Homer received his MD from the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine, and an MPH from the University of North Carolina School of Public Health.
