Dr. Lazorick is currently Assistant Professor of Pediatrics at the Brody School of Medicine at East Carolina University, focusing on childhood obesity research. She also teaches in the Master's of Public Health Program and serves as the director for medical student education in population health and prevention. She attended the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill for medical school and a master's degree in Public Health, remained there for residency training in combined Internal Medicine and Pediatrics, and after several years in clinical practice returned there for fellowship training in Primary Care Research and Preventive Medicine. During fellowship she gained experience with quality improvement methods in primary care and use of online CME to help teach quality improvement skills to clinicians. Her primary research interest is childhood obesity prevention in public health, community and clinical settings. She works with several state-wide efforts for obesity prevention in North Carolina and has served on several state committees for the Division of Public Health. She also serves on a national AAP planning group to help develop and improve the AAP's online educational program in quality improvement, eQIPP. Her clinical work is in a tertiary care clinic for obese children and supervising residents in an outpatient pediatric clinic.
